

That said, I appreciate the tenuous nature of the situation and I will keep all parents/ carers informed of any decisions necessary to keep our children and their families safe. Please be assured that if, after half term, if there is any need to close any bubble or year hub, our children will be able to access their learning, following their daily timetable, via our ITS Learning Platform with lessons delivered by teachers 'live' via Microsoft Teams. The links to these lessons will be added into each respective lesson for all courses. As a result, our remote learning plan is robust should school closure affect a tutor group or year group/ hub of children. Furthermore, if any child needs to selfisolate due to a family member having a positive diagnosis, then that child can continue to access the learning being delivered by staff in school that day, uploading work on completion to be assessed and contacting tutors if he/she has any questions.

On a personal note I want to extend my thanks to the whole school community— these are strange and uncertain times and I have really appreciated the warmth and support of the whole school community as we develop a different way of working. I feel fortunate to be able to come into work every day and work with such a committed and amazing team, lovely children and a really supportive parent/ carer and Governing body. REMOTE LEARNING

Following the government update, we have been working hard to ensure our remote learning provision is in place and easily accessible to families. The Government and school guidance can be found on our COVID page of the school website. These documents outline the expectations for remote learning during times of self-isolation for children or in the event of a bubble closure. Please take the time to read and familiarise yourself with these documents so that you can engage with remote learning for your child should the circumstance arise.

COVID COMMUNICATION

If your personal circumstances change over the weekend due to symptoms or a positive test, please message the school team via office@westmoorsmid.dorset.sch.uk so that immediate action can be taken to ensure that we keep our school community safe. Can we remind again that if your child is displaying symptoms, do not send them into school. This helps to protect everyone and reduces the possible transmission. Thank you in advance for supporting us with this.

HEALTHY SNACKS

As a school, we encourage the children to have healthy snacks at break and lunch time. This is important for all our children as they will need a healthy snack mid-morning to keep them going until lunchtime. In addition, please can children only bring water into school to drink throughout the day, keeping them hydrated. Many nutrients help our children's health but we know that Vitamin D and Vitamin C are especially important for supporting the immune system. Maybe try to include immune boosting foods which contains these nutrients such as eggs, oily fish, dark green leafy vegetables and berries – delicious and healthy!
